Welcome Spring with a fun-filled game of BINGO. **Registration is required.**

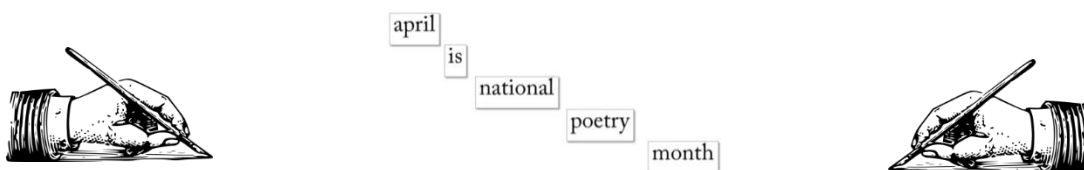
### Storytime Age 3 and older

## **Poetry Contest in April** **April 1<sup>st</sup> – 29<sup>th</sup> 2017**

### **GUIDELINES:**

- Writers must be in grades 1 to 12.
- Poem entries must be original work.
- Maximum of 1 poem per author may be entered.
- Poems cannot be longer than one 8 1/2 X 11 inch page.
- Poems must be typed or hand-written on white paper, with no illustrations or decorations.
- The author's name must not appear anywhere on the poem.
- The poem must have a title that should be centered at the top of the page.

### **DEADLINE:**

- **Entries will be taken April 1<sup>st</sup> – April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2017.** Entries must be received by 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 29<sup>th</sup>. Entries cannot be put in the book drop. E-mail entries will not be accepted.

Poems will be judged based on Spelling, Grammar, Style & Presentation, Impact, and Originality. **Contest winners will be announced May 19<sup>th</sup>, 2017.** All entries will be bound into a book for viewing at the library.
