Why we did this - a quote from a contributor

Where do you get photo enlargements?

I go to <u>In A Flash</u> in Springfield. Dave does a very professional job. He is willing to work with you to assure you get what you expect.

I get my enlargements from Bay Photo Lab in CA. They do very high-quality work.





You upload your images, select the size(s,) and you get your photos in a week. I love their metallic finish option. It gives colors a shine, especially browns, grays, and golds which come out looking like shiny metals.

Local camera shops that print can do a nice job for you, too.

Remember that a print on your screen is backlit and is about 10% brighter than prints will be. Box stores (Sam's, Walgreens, Wal-Mart) tend to print dark and I would avoid them. If you do print there, lighten your prints at the kiosk.

I've been getting my prints from Mpix.

I think they do good work and are reasonably priced.

I do my enlargements on-line at Professional Photo Printing & Photo Gifts | Nations Photo Lab

I try to sock away pictures and then do them on a sale. Another company is **Bay Photo Lab** — Professional Photo Printing | Digital Prints, Photo Canvas, MetalPrints, ThinWraps, Albums, Books, ROES

I'm not sure exactly what to tell you about the aluminum prints except that they are widely available and vary widely in quality. The best quality aluminum prints I've gotten made are from Bay Photo. I have used Adoramapix.com and found quality and consistency lacking. I've used Mpix.com with good print results, but they cost the same as Bay Photo and use particle board for backing which makes them vulnerable to moisture. There are many online print houses I haven't tried, and even places like CVS, Walgreens, Costco offer aluminum prints. Because of the expense it is important that the files you send out are prepared properly. If your monitor is too dark or too light you may get back a print that is different than what you expect. For photographers who don't insist on complete control over their images, Bay Photo offers color and white balance corrections of your files at a slightly higher price. If you are unsure about the accuracy your monitor this is a good idea.

Where do you go to get your photo framed, matted, and wired for hanging?

Frames and mats I've gotten from *Jerry's Artarama* in West Hartford. I buy standard size aluminum frames and mats and mount the pics in the frames myself. They also sell the wire on a spool and the clips that you can attach to the frame to attach the wire so I also do that myself.



I get all my prints done at *In A Flash* in Springfield near WNEC. You can email a large file to him with size and glossy or matter finish instructions. He can also do custom matting and framing. He sells standard size mats, too. I buy my frames at AC Moore. They are one of the few stores locally that have frames with backs that allow you to wire your own.

I print and matt my own images in my South Hadley Print Studio, as for frames a possible store would be *AC Moore* at the Holyoke Mall.

I get my frames and mats at *Michaels*. They have sales and coupons weekly in the Sunday paper. I have a wire cutter and buy wire in a roll at the hardware store.

For mats of very unique colors and special color combinations, *Golden State Art* is great!!! You can also buy mats boards in bulk (with backboard and plastic bag) for an exhibit or if you are preparing matted prints to sell.

I am a custom framer and sell to the public.

Most of my prints are made at labs that deal strictly with professional photographers. However, I sometimes use *Giclee of New England* in Palmer for giclee prints.

I don't know of any prohibition against Giclee prints. Photographic Society of America (PSA) rules for prints are pretty wide open.

From the PSA web site:

"The prints may be in color or monochrome. Digital capture, film photography, desktop and darkroom processing, and commercial prints are all included in the Division's activities. The content or subject matter of an image submitted to a PPD program or activity is unrestricted. There may be a theme specified for some PSA-recognized PPD exhibitions and the exhibition's definition of the theme should be consulted."

Paul's Picture Framing by Keith has made my frames and mats for over 20 years, and Keith is meticulous and fairly priced.

Affordable Framing in East Granby is also a good source.

As for ways to wire them for hanging on the Agawam library hanging system I can only share that for Bay Photo aluminum prints that are at least 16" wide I used clear hanging wire. I was able to thread it through the outer hanging openings on the back of the mounting plate and push the wire through the rigid foam that gives the mount its depth. Then I tied it off into a loop. Smaller prints only have one mounting hole in the center which makes them a little trickier for use on the Agawam system. It seems as though it would be difficult to get the lightweight prints to hang level using that single center loop.
