Celebrate Youth Art Month!

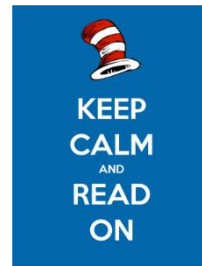
In celebration of Youth Art Month, the library will be displaying the works of Agawam students from Elementary, Doering and Junior High Schools.
