When the fillable PDF form opens save the file on your hard disk or to your cloud file system. The fillable form allows you to type your information with the unique feature that same fields need be entered only once. Being a 3-part form the Name appears in all three parts. Type your Name in one of the Name fields and when vou move on to the next field, the other two Name fields will automatically be populated with the same data. You can edit any field, then save the file on your hard disk or to your cloud, come back later to re-edit, and subsequently print. This fillable PDF form is designed to make entering your registration information simple and easy.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Please read Calendar of Events
- Multiple Entries per Category Allowed. Fee applies to each entry.
- Categories
 - Acrylics
 - Oils
 - Watercolors
 - Pastels
 - Other Media (pencil drawing, charcoals, pen and inks, block prints, collage, encaustics)
- 90% in one medium to be considered in that category
- Original art only. Jury selections will be based on the review of the original artworks, rather than on slides or jpegs.
- Wired for hanging with frame
- Wrap around frame acceptable
- Wired Frame edge-to-edge NOT TO EXCEED 26"H x 26"W
- No saw-tooth/clip hangers
- 5% contribution from artist for art sold. (Art may be marked NFS.)
- Non-refundable¹ entry fee.
 - Early-bird registration fee \$25 per entry, if mail entry form & check by Saturday Oct.14, 2017
 - Otherwise, \$30 after Sat. Oct. 14, 2017

Liability: All reasonable care and safety will be exercised in the handling, hanging, and storing of the art submitted. The Friends of the Agawam Public Library, the Library, and the town of Agawam will not be responsible for loss or damage to any item submitted.
