## **Poetry Contest in April** **April 2<sup>nd</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup> 2018**

### **GUIDELINES:**

- Writers must be in grades 1 to 12.
- Poem entries must be original work.
- Maximum of 1 poem per author may be entered.
- Poems cannot be longer than one 8 1/2 X 11 inch page.
- Poems must be typed or hand-written on white paper, with no illustrations.
- The author's name must not appear anywhere on the poem.
- The poem must have a title that should be at the top of the page.

### **DEADLINE:**

- **Entries will be taken April 2<sup>nd</sup> – April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018.** Entries must be received by 8:00 p.m. on Monday, April 30<sup>th</sup>. Entries cannot be put in the book drop. E-mail entries will not be accepted.

All entries will be bound into a book for viewing at the library.  
Poems will be judged based on Spelling, Grammar, Style & Presentation, Impact, and Originality.

**Contest winners will be announced May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2018.**
