Entries are being accepted now. Winning photographers will receive their awards at a Reception and Awards ceremony on Friday, February 17, beginning at 7 P.M. Plan to celebrate with us and take in the show.

All images must be captured with light sensitive material (either film or digital). • Jury selections will be based on the review of the original images, not digital files. • Wired for hanging with frame • No saw-tooth/clip hangers • Wired Frame edge-to-edge NOT TO EXCEED 22" H x 22" W

All images must be original and made by the photographer. • Digital manipulation is allowed in Creative and Pictorial Categories. • Digital manipulation is not allowed in Nature and Photojournalism Categories. • No Download images are allowed.
