If you just can't hold out until spring for great bargains, remember, good book buys are continually available at the sale shelves along the wall between the large print and periodical sections.



Do you know that the Agawam Public Library:

- Is the 5th most active library by circulation in the central and western Massachusetts areas? Activity only in Amherst, Chicopee, Springfield and Worcester libraries surpasses ours.
- Has about 19,000 library cards in circulation? That's over half the population of Agawam.
- Circulated 337,000 items, including electronic materials, for the fiscal year ending June 2012?
- Is a "net lender", which means the Library lends about 40,000 items to patrons of other libraries but borrows only about 26,000?
- Provides wireless service to about 600 people weekly, many of whom would probably be without another source of internet access?
- Does much, much more?

We have wonderful resources in our Library, not the least of which is an excellent staff. To help the Library fulfill its purpose in the community, the Friends strive to raise money to supplement the Library's budget. We do this with income primarily from membership fees, book sales, juried show entry fees, holiday basket raffles, and local business contributions.

We invite you to join us in support of our exceptional library. Plan to join or renew your membership for 2013. Categories and fees appear on the following page. If you can do more, consider the following opportunity.

Participate in Our 4th Annual Holiday Basket Raffle
