Happy fall to everyone, and good riddance to those brutally hot and humid days! We had a very productive spring and summer at the library. Our book sale was a great success, raising \$2400 to support the library. This was a ten percent increase over last year's sale. The Summer Reading program was also a huge success, with 811 participants. This was an almost twenty percent increase over last year, and our children read almost 300,000 minutes -an impressive achievement!

Over the past year our membership increased by 25% to 135 individuals and families. We began a sponsorship program for our Juried Fine Art Show, which will allow us to continue to provide a high-quality Art Show for our local artists and our library.

Cher Collins, Adult Services Librarian, was interviewed recently and she was the second staff person interviewed who said that working at the library is like having Christmas every day. The joy, enthusiasm, and dedication of the library staff is beyond impressive. Huge kudos to them and to Judy Clini, for bringing them all together.

A huge thank you also goes out to all of you, who generously continue to support the Friends with your time, money and spirit.

Meet Cher Collins Adult Services Librarian



Cher's enthusiasm and love for the library were obvious as soon as she started talking about her job. Although her mother tells her she played "library" as a child, she didn't consider it as a career until after she obtained a college degree in psychology. She worked part-time at the Springfield City library, and decided she wanted to be a librarian. She obtained her library degree at the University of Rhode Island.

Like all of the staff at our library, Cher wears many hats. Her primary responsibility, and her favorite part of her job, is maintaining the Adult collections. She chooses books for purchase, and makes a special effort to match these selections to the community. She also connects with the community by writing the monthly newsletter. Cher assists with the artist exhibitions at the library, and helps to plan special programs. Somewhere in her busy days, she also finds time to staff the Reference desk. There she helps patrons with problem-solving, another part of her job that she thoroughly enjoys.

It was fascinating to talk with Cher about how technology has affected her profession. As a reference librarian in the past, people would come to her with all kinds of questions that she would help them research. One of her most interesting challenges was to find out what coating is on the outside of spaceships. After an extensive search, she ended up referring the person to someone she found at NASA who could answer the question. This kind of resolution brings her great satisfaction. Cher shared that she never gives up on a question and always verifies. With the introduction of Google and other search engines, Cher's job now includes teaching computer basics and "helping beyond Google". She will identify reliable data bases for people and teach them how to evaluate the information they obtain.

Cher's future plans include a Mental Health Fair at the library for next spring, and a series of "How to" talks, using local talent to demonstrate and explain skills they have-anywhere from genealogy to making a braid.

In her "spare time", Cher is an amateur genealogist. Her favorite reading is United States historical fiction. She is passionate about the importance of reading aloud with children, and enjoys this with her fourth-grade daughter.
